Plenty of lambs above and around the £2 per kilo mark including Fountain and Sewell, Mrs. Howard, David Spanton, Mark Littmoden, Ben Wheeler and Hollycombe Farms. Top price per head was a deserved £99.50 to Dick Whyman taken by Tony Fulk closely attended by Fountain and Sewell taken by Tottingworth Farms and in third place David Spanton taken by Shaun Hutchings. There is no doubt that retail butchers make the job go, in particular Fulk, Howard and Hutchings. Gentlemen, we salute you.

Nationally trade was an appalling £54 per head, Hailsham averaged £63 per head. Clearly it makes sense to sell your ewes at Hailsham but please be warned that it is only the biggest ewes that are wanted by the "big factory" men. There were 16 lots which were sold in excess of £85 per head! Topping the lot was Dick Whyman at £109 and £94, closely attended by Mr. and Mrs. Clay at £99, Comptons at £92, Plumpton College at £89, Messrs. Pile at £88 twice and Washbrooks at £87 twice.
